**RECOMMENDATION:**

Find that the County of Santa Barbara is in conformance to the adopted Congestion Management Program pursuant to Section 65089.3 of the California Government Code

**SUMMARY:**

At its April 17, 2008 meeting, the SBCAG Board made a finding that the County of Santa Barbara was not in compliance with the requirements of the Congestion Management Program (CMP), due to the absence of required traffic count/level of service data. County staff submitted the required intersection count/level-of-service data to staff shortly thereafter. Therefore, staff is recommending that the Board make a finding that the County is now in compliance with the requirements of the CMP. Results of the intersection monitoring are provided below.

**2007 CMP Intersection Monitoring – Unincorporated Santa Barbara County**

Bradley Road/Lakeview Street	0.73 / LOS C
Route 135 / Foster Road	0.77 / LOS C
Bradley Road/Clark Avenue	0.62 / LOS B
San Ysidro Road / Foothill Road-Route 192	0.54 / LOS A
