### RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize Executive Director to send a letter to the City of Lompoc terminating the agreement to use city-owned vehicles in the Clean Air Express bus service.

### DISCUSSION:

In 2001 when SBCAG assumed management of the Clean Air Express commuter bus service from APCD, the agreement between APCD and the City of Lompoc to use city-owned vehicles in Clean Air Express service was assigned to SBCAG. The agreement has been in effect since 1996, when the City purchased the vehicles.

The City of Santa Maria will be assuming management of the Clean Air Express in July 2010. As part of this transition, the agreement between SBCAG and the City of Lompoc to use city owned vehicles in Clean Air Express service needs to be terminated. The City of Santa Maria has developed an agreement with the City of Lompoc to continue using Lompoc-owned vehicles for the service.

Dear Ms. Barcelona:

In 2001 when Santa Barbara County Association of Governments assumed management of the Clean Air Express commuter bus service from Air Pollution Control District, the agreement between APCD and the City of Lompoc to use city-owned vehicles in Clean Air Express service was assigned to SBCAG. The agreement has been in effect since March 21, 1996 and was assigned to SBCAG on September 20, 2001.

The City of Santa Maria will be assuming management of the Clean Air Express in July 2010. As part of this transition, the agreement between SBCAG and the City of Lompoc to use city owned vehicles in Clean Air Express service needs to be terminated. This letter serves as notice that the agreement originally dated March 21, 1996, to allow use of City owned vehicles in Clean Air Express service and assigned to SBCAG on September 20, 2001, will terminate on July 2, 2010, at 7:00PM.
