4. CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Recommend that the SBCAG board:

- A. Adopt a determination, pursuant to Section 65089.3 of the California Government Code that the Cities of Santa Maria, Solvang, Lompoc, Buellton, Santa Barbara, Goleta, and Carpinteria are conforming to the adopted Congestion Management Program.
- B. Adopt a determination, pursuant to Section 65089.3 of the California Government Code that in the absence of required submittals, the City of Guadalupe and the

County of Santa Barbara are not conforming to the adopted Congestion Management Program.

- C. Add the Route 192-Foothill Road intersection at San Ysidro Road to the CMP network of intersections. This intersection is located in the unincorporated County area of Montecito.
