This letter serves as notification to Caltrans and FHWA of the SBCAG 2009 FTIP Administrative Amendment #17. Pursuant to the authority delegated under the 2009 SBCAG FTIP, minor modifications to the 2009 FTIP will normally be handled as Administrative Amendments and may be approved at the discretion of the SBCAG Executive Director. I have given my approval to this amendment that makes the following changes to the project described below which is consistent with the requirements in 23 CFR 450:

- **Economic Stimulus Projects Lump Sum – Streets and Roads Projects** – (MPO ID: VAR05): Shift of \$1.5 million in Economic Stimulus Funds from Fiscal Year 2008/09 to 2009/10 for the Cold Spring Bridge project. Addition of \$2.6 million in local funding to Economic Stimulus Streets and Roads Projects Lump Sum in Fiscal Year 2009/10.
- **Economic Stimulus Projects Lump Sum – Bridge Projects** – (MPO ID: VAR06): Addition of \$100,000 in local funding to Economic Stimulus Bridge Projects Lump Sum in Fiscal Year 2009/10.
- **Economic Stimulus Projects Lump Sum – Bicycle and Pedestrian Projects** – (MPO ID: VAR07): Addition of \$300,000 in local funding to Economic Stimulus Bicycle and Pedestrian Projects Lump Sum in Fiscal Year 2009/10.
- **SHOPP Lump Sum Collision Reduction Program** – (MPO ID: SHOPP2) - Add new project to lump sum for Fiscal Year 10/11. Total project cost of \$1.023 million.
- **SHOPP Lump Sum Mandates Program** – (MPO ID: CT24) – Increase funding for Right of Way for Project PPNO 1884 – Increase from \$218,000 to \$381,000.


The 2009 FTIP remains financially constrained.
