The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments' (SBCAG) 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

26	Local Element <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Amendment modifies funding for the Highway Bridge Program grouped project listing (MPO Id: CT14) based on the updated statewide program list dated April 16, 2010.• Amendment deletes various projects funded from the anticipated Jobs for Main Street Act of 2010 as the proposed act did not get enacted.

The updated programming is for projects in an air quality attainment area that are exempt from the conformity determination requirement. The SBCAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that projects included are consistent with the Regional Transportation Plan, are financially constrained, and meet the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SBCAG.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me, I approve SBCAG's Amendment Number 26. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
